

ORDINANCE NO. 37

MASTER OF LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE

(Sec. 37 (ii) and 39 (i) )

The course of study for this degree shall be of one year duration.

The minimum qualification for admission to this Course is prescribed as Under :-

The candidates shall have passed B. Lib. I Sc. of Jiwaji University or of any other University recognised by Jiwaji University as equivalent to B. Lib. I. Sc., provided that such candidates have obtained a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate.

Out of the total seats, 20 % of the seats shall be reserved for whole time paid, in service candidates having experience of atleast three successive years in a Library of repute and fulfilling the conditions stipulated as above. Such candidates will be required to produce a certificate of experience alongwith the permission from their present employer. The reserved seats will be filled in order of merit, provided that the deputed/ in service candidates will be required to work as full time students like other students.

The University examination for the Master of Library and Information Science will be held at the end of March/April every year.

No candidate shall be deemed to have pursued a regular course of study for the academic year unless he/she attended not less than 75 % of the lectures, tutorials, seminars etc. taken together.,

The minimum number of marks required to pass the examination shall be as under :-

- (a) 40 % in each Theory paper.
- (b) 50 % in total aggregate.
- (c) 50 % in Dissertation/Project work/Literature survey.

For a pass in First Division, a candidate should secure 60% or more in the aggregate number of marks, for Second Division he/she must secure 50 % or more but less than 60 %. Candidates securing less than 40 % marks in individual papers and less than 50 % marks in VIII paper (Research Project / Dissertation / Literature Survey ) will be treated as failed.

7. The candidates who fail in the final examination will have to re-appear in all the papers in the examination of the following years as an ex-student.

8. The Project Work/Dissertation/Literature Survey shall have to be submitted at least one month before the commencement of theory examination.

9. A candidate who fails to secure 50 % marks in Dissertation/Project Work/Literature Survey shall be required to submit a revised or a fresh Project Report/Dissertation/Literature Survey on a subject to be assigned by the Head of the Library and Information Science. The candidate shall be required to attend the department for the supervision of his/her work as required by the Head of the Department.
