ORDINANCE NO. 41 IMPROVEMENT OF PERCENTAGE/PERFORMANCE

Candidates who have been declared successful at the final examination of Post-Graduate Course of this University, shall be eligible to appear at the examination again in the theory papers of the same subject for improvement of parcentage without being required to further attend a regular course of study in teaching Department of the University or in a college affiliated to this University. Practical/dissertation/sessional marks of such candidates will carried forward.

Provided that such candidates shall be admitted to the examination concerned as a candidate for the improvement of percentage performance. They shall be required to fulfil all conditions laid down in this and other relevant ordinance & regulations for admission to an examination, save in so far as the expressed provisions of this ordinance are contrary to any other provisions of other ordinances.

Permission for improvement of percentage may be given only upto five years after the candidate has passed the Final Examination in the subject wherein he/she desires to improve the percentage.

The conditions for passing the examination shall be the same prescribed in the relevant post-graduate ordinances of the examination concerned.

Provided that before the result is declared such candidates shall be required to surrender his originals of the Marks Statement/Degree.

The result of a candidate shall be declared if the candidate has improved percentage.

Provided that the candidate will take the examination according to the current syllabus in force for the regular students for that examination.

Not more than one atempt shall be allowed to a candidate for improvement of his/her percentage.

In the case of such candidates who have passed the Previous examination for a Master's degree from some other University and have passed the Final examination, from the University, they may be permitted to appear for improvement of division percentage only in the Final examination and not in the Previous.

A candidate for the improvement of percentage may be given only the Kulapati's grace mark for passing or for awarding a division.

Improvement of percentage shall not count towards any position in merit, gold medal, prizes, etc.

A candidate for the improvement of the percentage shall be required to opt once only to appear in Previous/Final or Previous and Final examinations both. Such a candidate will have to intimate the University his intention of doing so on the prescribed form with fee.

A candidate who appears in any examination for improvement of percentage shall not be allowed to take any other eaxmination of the University simultaneously, except for a Certificate/Diploma course.

If a candidate is unable to improve his performance after taking the examination for improvement of the percentage, his/her previous result will stand.

No revaluation will be allowed in such examination.

In case this ordinance does not provide remedy to any problem the decision of the Vice Chancollor shall be final.
