

Ordinance No - 70 (Rural Technology & Management)

ORDINANCE FOR THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF (RURAL TECHNOLOGY AND MGT.)
(A THREE YEAR MULTILEVEL FULL TIME PROGRAMME)

The ordinance provides for admission, examination and other incidental matters relating to the Bachelor of Rural Technology and Management (a three years multilevel full time programme). The programme will be run by the Directorate of Distance Education, Jiwaji University, Gwalior but academically administered by the Faculty of Management, Jiwaji University, Gwalior.

ADMISSION :

A candidate seeking admission to the first year of the course shall be required to (a) Possess a 10+2 qualification in any discipline with second division (at least 45% marks in aggregate).

Admission to the first year of this course shall be made on the merit basis of only mark-sheets of 10+2. These will be finalised and declared by an Admission Committee of three members nominated by the Kulpati.

An applicant, subsequently admitted and prosecuting a full-time course of study leading to the Degree of BRTM, shall not be permitted to take-up any other examination or course of this university simultaneously.

The candidate who has passed any part of BRTM programme of any other university/institution will not be admitted to BRTM programme of this university on migration basis.

Each candidate of BRTM programme shall have to work at any recognised centre in rural areas/villages to carry out his field work/practical/project work etc. for a minimum period of days in a year.

Each candidate will have to complete a minimum 75% attendance in each contact programme. Such two contact programmes will be organised by the Directorate of Distance Education in one year.

Each identified centre shall have the number of students from 25 to 50. Each centre will be supervised by one course co-ordinator. If the number exceeds 50, two centres shall be organised at the same location.

The candidate entering the course after 10+2 shall have to choose certain course suited to his/her aptitude and need. After successfully acquiring 20 credits in the first year, the candidate shall have the option to leave the course and get himself/herself self-employed. Such candidates will be awarded certificate indicating the courses covered and credits earned by them. After two years of successful completion if they leave the course, they will be awarded Diploma and after three years completion of the course, degree of BRTM will be awarded to them.

The pattern of BRTM course will be extremely flexible in which a candidate shall have the option to leave the course after one/two years of successful completion and rejoin the course of the subsequent stage, within 3 years if he/she so desires. The courses shall be so designed that at each stage his acquired knowledge and skill shall be complete.

EXAMINATION :-

Subject to the provisions of this ordinance, the scheme of examination and the syllabus and text books, will be prescribed or recommended in connection with any subject for any of the examination covered by this ordinance and the conditions on which the students shall be admitted to such examination, shall be in accordance with the provisions made by the Academic Council after considering the recommendations of the concerned Board of Studies and the Faculty of Management.

Each examination shall be regarded as a separate unit for the purpose of working out the result of the candidate. The result of each examination shall be worked out separately even if he/she has appeared at the course in which he/she failed previously, alongwith the course in which he/she is appearing for the first-time for getting success, he/she must have secured atleast 36% marks in the individual courses/papers.

The medium of instruction and examination for this programme, shall be English/Hindi.

(4)

A candidate appearing in any examination, shall be examined in accordance with the existing scheme and syllabi in force at that time.

Candidate shall be entitled to the award of the Certificate/Diploma/Degree of the year of the particular stage in which all the courses are cleared by him/her.

(6)

Division shall be awarded on the following basis :

- (i) FIRST DIVISION : 60% and above in aggregate
- (ii) SECOND DIVISION : 45% and above but below 60% in aggregate.
- (iii) PASS IN THIRD DIVISION: 36% and above but below 45% in aggregate.

A student of BRTM (of any year) will be entitled to the benefit of Vice Chancellor's grace of one mark for passing the examination of any year or obtaining the next division (if he loses the next division by only one mark in aggregate).

The course structure, procedure of admission will be finalised by Head and Dean of BRTM. Programme under the guidance of Board of studies in Management, subject to the approval of Faculty of Management and Hon. Vice Chancellor.
